### **Credit Union Names Chief Technology Officer** *Brad Williams, former VP of IT, joins senior management team*

(N. CHARLESTON, S.C.) – July 1, 2008 -- South Carolina Federal Credit Union is pleased to announce the newest addition to its senior management team.

**Brad Williams**, formerly vice president of information technology at South Carolina Federal, on June 27 became the credit union's chief technology officer.

Williams joined South Carolina Federal in 2000. As vice president of technology, he was responsible for the technology infrastructure that now supports over 500 employees, 23 branches and 80 ATMs.

Williams began his information technology career in 1995 as a trainer with Summit Information Systems/FiServ, where he converted data processing systems for multiple credit unions and served on teams assigned to the largest and most difficult installations.

From 1996 to 2000, Williams was vice president of information technology at D.M. Federal Credit Union, where he was responsible for the technology infrastructure that supported 200 employees, 13 branches and more than 25 ATMs. He developed and presented future technology proposals to the board of directors and led that credit union through its Y2K compliance and testing.

“For the past several years, Brad has worked directly with the senior management team and board of directors, having served as an advisor to both the Security Team and Technology Committee of the board of directors,” said South Carolina Federal President and CEO Scott Woods. “During that time, he provided invaluable strategic counsel that assisted the board in making critical decisions relating to technology and system enhancements to benefit our membership and bring cost-savings to the credit union.”
