A money spending game

Building a snowman is a classic winter activity! With this game, you can “buy” fun accessories for your snowman and practice counting money.

Instructions:

1. With a grown-up’s help, gather some coins from around the house.
2. Draw a snowman with three stacked circles on a blank piece of paper.
3. Use the price list below to buy your snowman’s accessories! Count your coins carefully, because once you run out, the game ends.

Price List:

- Hat.....26¢
- Eyes.....15¢
- Carrot nose.....7¢
- Coal mouth.....8¢
- Scarf.....11¢
- Arms.....33¢
- Mittens.....12¢
- Broom.....16¢



Saving Throughout the year Adds Up!

As we enter 2025, consider starting a small savings habit. Asking a parent or caregiver for their loose change, saving money from an allowance, or adding money regularly to your [Kids Savings](#) account can make a big difference.

One fun goal is to save an amount equal to your age each week. Here’s what your savings could look like by the end of the year:

- 1-year-olds saving **\$1** each week will have **\$52**
- 2-year-olds saving **\$2** each week will have **\$104**
- 3-year-olds saving **\$3** each week will have **\$156**
- 4-year-olds saving **\$4** each week will have **\$208**
- 5-year-olds saving **\$5** each week will have **\$260**
- 6-year-olds saving **\$6** each week will have **\$312**

Saving even small amounts can grow over time!



Bring Winter Inside with Snow Playdough

Bring the fun of snow indoors with this easy playdough recipe! With a grown-up’s help, you can make your own glittery, snowy playdough—no need to wait for cold weather!

Ingredients:

- 1 cup flour
- ½ cup salt
- 1 teaspoon cream of tartar
- 2 teaspoons of glitter
- 1 cup water
- 1 teaspoon cooking oil

To make snow playdough, mix flour, salt, cream of tartar, and glitter in a large saucepan. Add water and oil. Stir until everything is well combined. With an adult’s help, heat the mixture on medium, stirring often.

In a few minutes, it’ll reach a playdough consistency. Let it cool, and then have fun with your indoor “snow!”
