- 3-year-olds saving \$3 each week will have \$156
- 4-year-olds saving \$4 each week will have \$208
- 5-year-olds saving \$5 each week will have \$260
- 6-year-olds saving \$6 each week will have \$312

- ½ cup salt
- 1 teaspoon cream of tartar
- 2 teaspoons of glitter
- 1 cup water
- 1 teaspoon cooking oil

To make snow playdough, mix flour, salt, cream of tartar, and glitter in a large saucepan. Add water and oil. Stir until everything is well combined. With an adult's help, heat the mixture on medium, stirring often.

In a few minutes, it'll reach a playdough consistency. Let it cool, and then have fun with your indoor "snow!"
