All you need to know about coins, cash, checks, and cards



Understanding the different ways to use money can help you make smart choices when you spend or save. Here is what you need to know:

- Coin A coin is a piece of metal that is typically flat and round. They come in various sizes, and each one—such as the penny, nickel, dime, and quarter—is worth a different amount
- Cash Cash is paper money of different values and the most commonly used form of payment.
- Check A check is a special piece of paper that you can use to pay for things instead of cash. When you write a check, you are telling your financial institution to give money from your checking account to the person or business you are paying.
- Card A debit card is a plastic card that is linked to your checking account that you can use to pay for things. Instead of using cash, you can swipe or tap the card and the money comes directly from your account.


